Reference for Supreme Heating (Craig Doncon)


Supreme Heating, under its Western Australia agent, Craig Doncon, recently completed the installation of a solar thermal hot water system on the roof of the Goldfields Oasis Leisure Centre using commercial Heat-Seeker Plus matting material. The brief called for a solar water heating system capable of generating 1,000 kwh per year of thermal energy for heating water in a ten lane Olympic pool and supplementary leisure pool.

The works were carried out expeditiously and with minimal issues. Craig and his team worked very cooperatively with our staff on site and our consultant to ensure minimal disruption to operations at the centre. Furthermore, Craig was very helpful in assisting us with our requested variation to reposition and redesign the solar matting layout so that we could optimize the simultaneous installation of a roof mounted solar PV system. We also engaged Craig and his team to install roof access and a walkway system for both of these solar installations and that was also completed successfully.

The early results of the solar water heating installation, based on recordings from the month of February 2013, indicate that the savings in gas consumption has exceeded the expectations outlined at project inception. A couple of minor teething issues experienced during that first month have been actioned by Craig in a timely and professional manner.

I would not hesitate to recommend Craig and the Supreme Heating team for future such projects.
